


On a beautiful summer day, a boy named Q was doodling in his notebook. He sketched a brand new type of creation: a clab!





"Welcome to Create Mode Metropolis, Clabby! How can I help?" responded Captain Bot.


"Well," the clab explained, "Hundreds of pounds of pasta have been dumped near Sinkhole 2023! Do you know why?"






### Captain Bot showed one of Q's ideas.

Using Captain Bot's Al powers -






"Thank you so much, Captain Bot!" the clab exclaimed, gathering the inventions. He teleported back to the sinkhole to get started on solving this mystery.

The clab thought she seemed familiar, so he sneakily followed behind her. She turned into an inventor's workshop and covered a large machine with a blanket.








It looks like a plant and has a garbage symbol on it. It is eco-generated and solar powered.



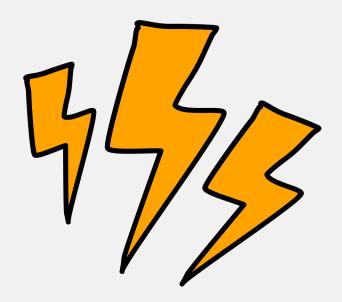
"Wow, it sounds like you are a talented engineer! Though, the machine probably does need a safety switch," the clab said encouragingly.




